## Madras Students Asked to Write for State Encyclopedia

Students at Madras High School will be working with The Oregon Encyclopedia (OE), to expand its online historical website at [www.oregonencyclopedia.org](http://www.oregonencyclopedia.org). This year, OE is reaching out to high school, community college, and university students and asking them to research and write about local topics important to their communities. Madras High School's students -- under the leadership of teachers, Courtney Lupton, Allen Hair and Catherine Sergeant -- will participate in the program along with five other classrooms throughout the state.

Through workshops led by OE staff, students will have "hands-on" experience with researching and writing as they learn about their own rich history. Students will visit local libraries and the Museum at Warm Springs archives, to support their historical research.

The OE is a partnership between Portland State University (PSU), Oregon Council of the Teachers of English (OCTE), and Oregon Historical Society (OHS). The partnership between Madras High School and OE is possible through a grant from the federal Institute of Museum and Library Services through the Library Services and Technology Act administered by the Oregon State Library.
