

Impact Aid Action Plan 2024--2027

- 1. To increase the sense of belonging for Native American students in their school community through increasing the presence of culture, language, and activities in our schools.
 - The percentage of Native American elementary school students who feel like they are a real part of their school's community will increase by 3% from 32% in 2023 to 33% in 2024, to 34% in 2025, and to 35% in 2026 as measured by the annual Youth Truth Survey, administered in January of each school year.
 - The percentage of Native American middle school students who feel like a part of their school's community will increase by 3% from 44% in 2023, to 45% in 2024, to 47% in 2025, and to 48% in 2024 as measured by the annual Youth Truth Survey, January in January of each school year.
 - The percentage of Native American high school students who feel like a part of their school's community will increase by 3% from 31% in 2023, to 32% in 2024, to 33% in 2025, and to 34% in 2026 as measured by the annual Youth Truth Survey, January of each school year.
 - Increase the presence and number of cultural events for Native American Students in our district annually as measured by the number of events and activities sponsored.
- 2. To increase native language instruction in our schools for our Native American students and families, and collaboratively develop a plan to grow future Native Language Teachers.
 - Increase the number of the language classes available to students and families in our district annually by 3% as measured by participation rates.
 - o Increase K8 student's participation/enrollment in Native Language Classes by 3% from 166 in 2023-24 by 3% to 171 in 2024-25, to 176 in 2025-26, and to 181 in 2026-27. O Increase High School student's participation in Native Language Classes by 3% from 87 in 2023-24 by 3% to 90 in 2024-25, to 93 in 2025-26, and to 96 in 2026-27.
- 3. To increase Native American secondary student involvement in sports and activities during the 2023-24 school year.
 - Increase the number of Native American students participating in sports and activities by 3% annual from 594 in 2022-23 to 612 in 2023-24, to 630 in 2024-25, and to 649 in 2025-26 as measured by the annual student participation data.
- 4. Support Native American students with opportunities for homework assistance and tutoring:
 - Increase the percentage of Native American 9th grade students earning 6 or more credits by 3% annually from 73% in 2022-23, to 75% in 2023-24, to 77% in 2024-25, to 79% in 2025-26, and to 82% in 2026-27 as measured annually by the State of Oregon.
 - Increase the four-year graduation rate for Native American students by 1% annually from 79% in 2023-24 to 80% in 2024-25, and 81% in 2025-26, and to 83% in 2026-27 as measured by the State of Oregon Graduation Data.
